

Out of Gauge (AOO) misdeclaration fee in North Europe will be implemented

Dear Customer,

On [December 1, 2023](#) we shared our local charges and trade fees on our [website](#), including a direct link to an overview [document](#). One of the changes mentioned in the overview was related to the implementation of the Out of Gauge (OOG) misdeclaration fee (AOO) for under-declared cargo.

In case you missed the update, here's what you need to know:

- The OOG misdeclaration fee (AOO) will be implemented for under-declared cargo from January 1, 2024.
- The fee is applicable to all OOG shipments in 20', 40' open top and flat rack containers that either exceed the booked dimensions at gate-in or are gated in as OOG but are shipments within normal dimensions.
- The penalty will be applied whenever the under-declaration results in additional lost slots.
- The OOG declaration will be container-number specific.
