CMA CGM announces a Contingency CHARGE with immediate effect

Dear Valued Customer,

Further to our previous Customer Advisories about the situation in Red Sea, several group vessels have been re-routed from their intended route through the cape of Good Hope to ensure the safety of our crew, the vessel, and your cargo.

As announced earlier, the contingency plan is undertaken according to the clause 10 of our bill of lading and will generate additional costs that are eligible for recovery.

A Contingency charge will be applicable from January 20, 2024 and until further notice as follows:

Amount: USD 1250 per 20' DRY, USD 1575 per 40' DRY, USD 2100 per REEFER & special equipment

Origin Range: All ports in North Europe including North France, United Kingdom, Ireland, Scandinavia, Poland, Baltic, Portugal, Spain (Bilbao, Vigo, Gijon) + All Mediterranean ports including Malta, France (Fos/Marseilles), Italy, Spain (Algeciras, Valencia, Barcelona, Sagunto), Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Cyprus, Greece, Turkey, Lebanon, Morocco excluding Egypt

Destination Range: To all US North Atlantic ports (New York, Norfolk), South Atlantic (Charleston, Savannah, Miami), all US Gulf ports (Houston, New Orleans), Mexico East Coast, Canada East Coast

Cargo: All types

Date of application: from January 20, 2024 (all cargo type)
