On January 5, 2024, our vessel Maersk Iowa suffered a crack on an internal tank while she was en route from Houston to Norfolk.

After completing a full inspection on the vessel, it has been determined that she can safely continue her voyage to Norfolk and onward journey from there to Antwerp, Belgium. At this

time, we are not expecting a delay to the service but we will keep customers informed if anything changes.

Upon Maersk Iowa's arrival at Antwerp, all units will be discharged to allow the vessel to undergo essential tank repair work.

Cargo previously set to discharge at Rotterdam and Bremerhaven will be connected to the Maersk Kansas for final delivery.
