How it works

The Track & Trace API enables you to access detailed information on Shipment-, Equipment-, and Transport-events for all your shipments booked with Hapag-Lloyd since the January 25, 2024. Leveraging the DCSA Track & Trace v.2.2 API specification, you can:

- Retrieve track and trace information based on:
 - 1. Carrier Booking Reference
 - 2. Equipment Reference
 - 3. Transport Document Reference
 - 4. Track by a combination of the above-mentioned references:
 - Carrier Booking Reference, Equipment Reference, or Transport Document Reference
 - Additionally, use any of the following parameters:
 - 1. Transport Document Type
 - 2. Vessel IMO number
 - 3. Carrier Voyage Number
 - 4. Carrier Service Code
 - 5. Event Type Code from the carrier
