

## Another new Turkish liner heads to Russia

A new Turkish liner has unveiled a service connecting with Russia.

Istanbul-based ULD Shipping has debuted a new Black Sea feeder that connects Turkey with Novorossiysk, using two chartered-in 634 teu sisterships, according to Alphaliner.

While most of the main global carriers have stopped servicing Russia since the start of the war in Ukraine two years ago, a host of names, including new liner brands from

Turkey, have rapidly moved to fill the gap including FESCO, Reel Shipping, New New Shipping/Torgmoll, OVP, Safetrans, Mountain Air Shipping, Neco, Modul and Global Field Line.
