

# ONE revamps Korea-China-Straits 2 service

Ocean Network Express (ONE) announced the enhancement of the KCS2 (Korea-China-Straits 2) service.

The effective vessel will be KMTCL DALIAN, Voy 2407S, estimated to arrive at Pusan, South Korea, on 4 July.

The updated port rotation will be as follows:

PUSAN, South Korea > INCHEON, South Korea > QINGDAO, China > SHANGHAI, China > SINGAPORE > PORT KLANG, Malaysia > CAT LAI, Vietnam > SHEKOU, China
