



Update: Labour relations between MEA and the Longshore Workers Union

Most recent update: September 26, 2024

Status of the situation: strike Mandate

Following a vote on September 24th and 25th, the Port of Montreal Longshoremen's Union, Local 375, CUPE, voted by a majority to adopt a strike mandate.

At this stage, obtaining the strike mandate does not affect port operations: no disruption of port services can occur before a party has provided a 72-hour notice. However, the Montreal Port Authority is preparing to manage the operational impacts should such notice be given.

In the interest of transparency, you can follow the evolution of the situation on this web. A newsletter will also be distributed to Port of Montreal users and other stakeholders as the situation evolves.
