NexusWave offers an "office-like" and "home-like" experience, ensuring continuous connectivity without concerns about usage limits, quotas, or speeds. Additionally, NexusWave includes an upgrade path to the ViaSat-3 network.

Tailored to meet specific customer needs, NexusWave uses SD-WAN technology for intelligent traffic management and prioritization, ensuring uninterrupted connectivity for mission-critical operations while supporting video-based services like remote inspections. Additionally, it separates business and crew welfare channels to enhance connectivity for both.

Moreover, NexusWave encrypts traffic at the vessel level and employs advanced enterprise-grade infrastructure trusted by leading enterprises and governments globally to increase the security levels.
