End of the Lockout: Still No Outcome in Sight for Dockworkers at the Port of Quebec

Resolution of the conflict at the Port of Quebec is taking longer than expected, as no return-towork protocol has yet been negotiated a month after the federal government's announcement.

On November 12, the arbitration imposed by Ottawa meant in some way the end of a 27-month lockout.

This decision by Ottawa was supposed to end an interminable confrontation, but in all likelihood no workers will return before Christmas. No date has yet been put forward.
