We are pleased to announce the official launch of the "DAY 9 Product" as part of the renewed OCEAN Alliance, effective from April 2025 (except Transpacific on May 1, 2025). This offering prioritizes punctuality and reliability in delivering services to our customers, at a time when ships must be routed through the Cape of Good Hope.

The CMA CGM Group, COSCO Shipping, Evergreen and OOCL launch OCEAN Alliance "DAY 9 Product". Following the renewal of the partnership until 2032 last year, this renewed set up program marks CMA CGM's commitment to continue offering its customers the highest quality of service and providing stability and continuity.

Due to the unstable situation in the Red Sea, ships will continue to be routed through the Cape of Good Hope until further notice. However, we are fully prepared to resume routing through the Suez Canal if the Red Sea crisis is resolved. CMA CGM and its partners are actively coordinating to maintain the same high standards of visibility, reliability, and punctuality that define the OCEAN Alliance.
