
Shipping with our Caribbean Express Service - CES? Here's a service update

From end of February 2025, our <u>CES</u> service will operate with an updated rotation with additional calls at Philadelphia, US and Port Everglades, US and will no longer call Norfolk, US & Kingston, JM.

This enhanced service will enable you to load between Europe, Canada, USA and various ports in the Caribbean.



For your reference, here's an overview of the new rotation:

 Rotation: Antwerp, BE -> London Gateway, GB -> Hamburg, DE -> Rotterdam, NL -> Antwerp, BE -> Saint John, CA -> Philadelphia, US -> Port Everglades, US -> Santa Marta, CO -> Puerto Limon, CR -> Caucedo, DO -> Antwerp, BE

In case you'd like to plan ahead, here is the first port call of the new rotation, including vessel voyage, Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA), port and week:

Kingston, JM will be removed from the rotation, but you will still be able to book from/to this port via transshipment in Cartagena, CO on our South America Westcoast Express Service (<u>SWX</u>). Norfolk, US will be served direct on our <u>AL1</u> service.
